- Harvest continuing in Drapers 3 Road in Puketiro Forest, with ongoing road closures on Puketiro Road
- Harvesting operations continue along Rallywoods road between marker 13 and 11km. Vehicle traffic will be able to travel this road unimpeded before 8:00am and after 4:30pm. In between times there will be road closures in place and traffic will need to get in touch with the crew to proceed through banners. Delays can be expected. Map attached.
- Thinning to waste Blowfly road beyond marker 21km.
- **Logging traffic along Puketiro, Rallywoods, Airstrip, Valley View, Lindsays and Ragworts roads between 4am and 5pm weekdays. Radio communication on these roads at all times.**
- **Following the recent wet weather, extra caution is required when driving on all the forests roads. Hazards including fallen trees, and debris, washouts and slips are likely. Drive to the conditions.**
- **The logging radio frequency will change on the 11<sup>th</sup> of May. The current frequency will not be usable in the forest from this date. Contact Richard Beamish-White (029 770 6223)**

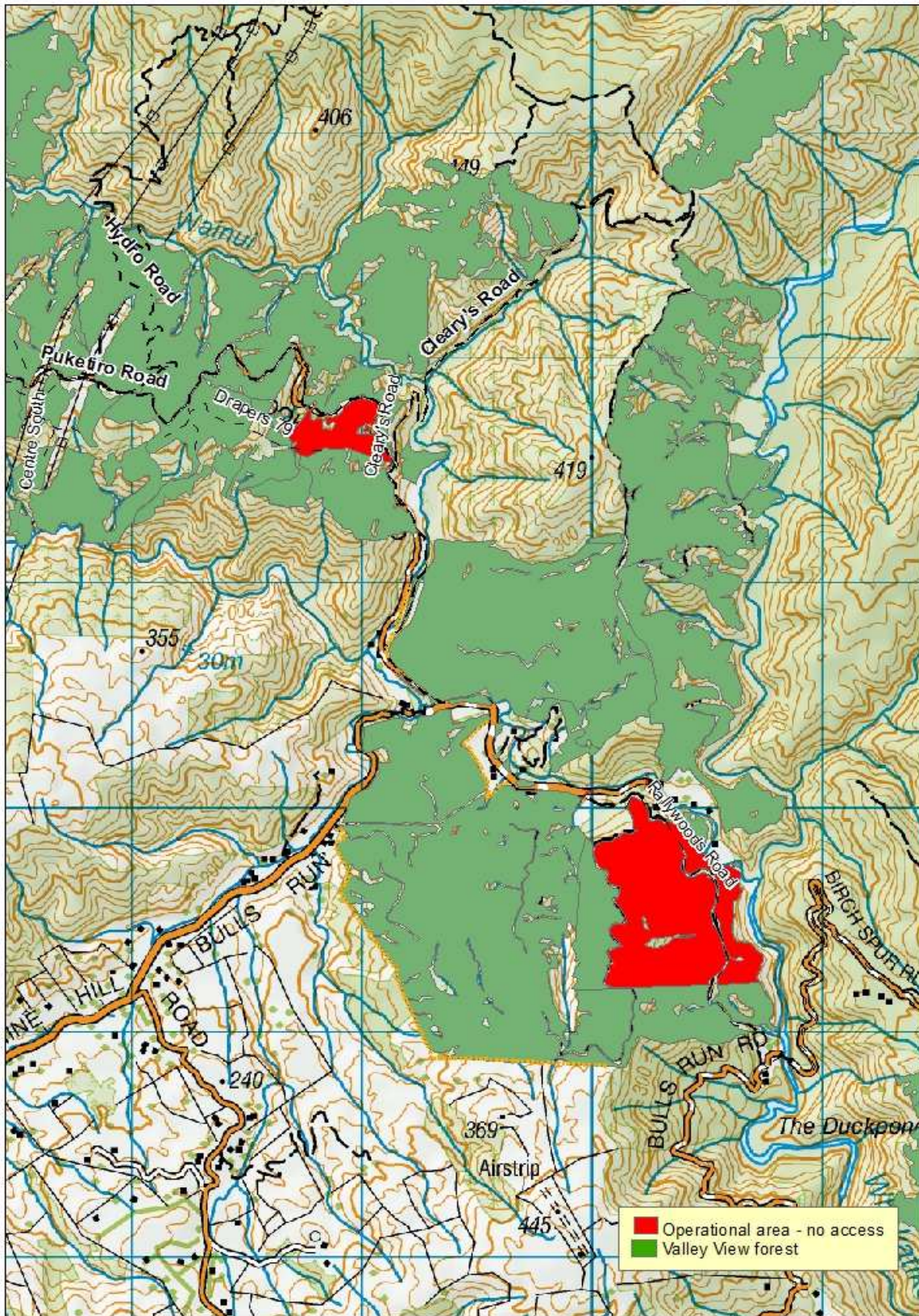
- Roadside mowing along access road from gates on Twin Lakes Road.

## Akatarawa Forest Block

- **Greater Wellington Regional Council Rangers will be on Duty throughout the Forest**
- **Causeway Closed to vehicles due to wash out.**
- Broad Spectrum undergoing pylon maintenance in Puketiro / Hydro Road January – February
- **Tobins Limited** – Pylon maintenance (blasting and painting) will be carried out during the year (weather dependant) by Tobin's Ltd. Vehicles and crew will be entering and exiting Maungakotukutuku gate
- **Electrix Limited** – is working in conjunction with United Group on the Pylons off Hydro Road
- **Transpower** – Pylon maintenance on going may involve heavy machinery on Hydro Road. Helicopter Inspection of transmission lines 15<sup>th</sup> -22<sup>nd</sup> of February 2016 Whakatikei Forest, Hydro Valley Road
- **Police dog training school** – will be ongoing on the roads within the Valley View area, Valley View Forest
