Extra caution is required when driving on all the forests roads. Hazards including fallen trees, washouts debris and slips are likely.

Note:

- **Valley View Road: Moonshine Road and Bulls Run Roads are currently closed to heavy traffic. Therefore logging trucks entering and exiting the forest via Valley View. Take extra care on Valley View Road with increased traffic volumes. Stop and perform radio check at the Totara Park Gate to ensure your comm's are working correctly, be extra cautious between the 1km and 2km markers.**
- **Track Closure: Southern Hydro Road and Zig Zag**
- **Track closed until further notice from Puketiro Road/Hydro Road junction to Hydro Saddle due to storm damage, significant surface erosion and slips.**
- **Slip on Clearys Road pass with care.**
- **Extra care needed when using all ford crossings.**
- **Whakatikei causeway culvert closed due to washout.**
- **Whakatikei wetland closed to all motorised recreation users.**

Plantation Forestry

Valley View Forest

- Road construction and maintenance to recommence on Lyndsays Road from the 12 K mark.
- Grader working on Valley View Rd and Airstrip Rd as weather conditions allow.
- New Zealand Manuka Group installing Bee hives middle to late next week. Once installed they will be feeding and monitoring these right through until the end of June 2017.
- Valley View road operating 2 way traffic for foreseeable future. Logging trucks and other heavy vehicles operating both ways.
- Aerial spraying Lyndsays's Road from marker 10 and Spring Road areas. Obey signage and follow instructions on the day.

Hukinga Forest

- SPS Inventory contractor working in forest. 1 light vehicle.

Puketiro Forest

- **Use caution between the 14 - 16km markers on Puketiro Road, harvesting waste left on the hillside above the road could pose a risk. No stopping at anytime.**
- **Log extraction to commence above Rallywoods Rd between Rallywoods Gate and 12km markers. Signage in place... New road construction occurring of Blowfly Rd towards the Wainui Stream...**
- Cable Hauler working alongside Rallywoods Road between the 12K and 13K markers. Obey all signage.
- Grader working on Rallywoods Rd, Cooks Ridge Rd and Puketiro Rd as weather conditions allow.
- SPS inventory contractor working in forest, 1 light vehicle.
- Log extraction to commence above Rallywoods Road between Rallywoods Gate and 12km markers. Signage in place and all traffic to call in before passing through banners.
- New road construction occurring of Blowfly Rd towards the Wainui Stream into Kaikamako area. Beware of machine and truck movements.
- Road maintenance Puketiro road, Rallywoods Rd, Drapers road, Main loop Rd.
- Harvesting Main Loop Road area. No access to this area while harvesting in progress. Some disruption to access along Rallywoods road during this operation. Obey signage. Do not approach working machinery unless authorised by the harvesting crew. This operational area off limits to recreational use.
- Logging traffic along Puketiro, Rallywoods roads between 4am and 5pm weekdays. Radio communication on these roads at all times. Controlled area and Banner in place on Puketiro Road week days, make contact with logging crew on radio and do not proceed until given the all clear to do so.
- Wainui stream works commencing upstream of the Cleary's road crossing. Stay clear of stream and machine during this operation.
- Aerial Spraying Cleary's road, Drapers road, Number 9 road, main loop and Rallywoods road areas. Obey signage and follow instructions on the day.
- Aerial Spraying Cleary's road, Drapers road, Number 9 road, main loop and Rallywoods road areas. Obey signage and follow instructions on the day.

- Logging traffic along Puketiro, Rallywoods roads between 4am and 5pm weekdays. Radio communication on these roads at all times.

Fire Danger

There are to be no fires lit within the exotic forest estate. Any fires need to be reported to the PF Olsen forest manager immediately.

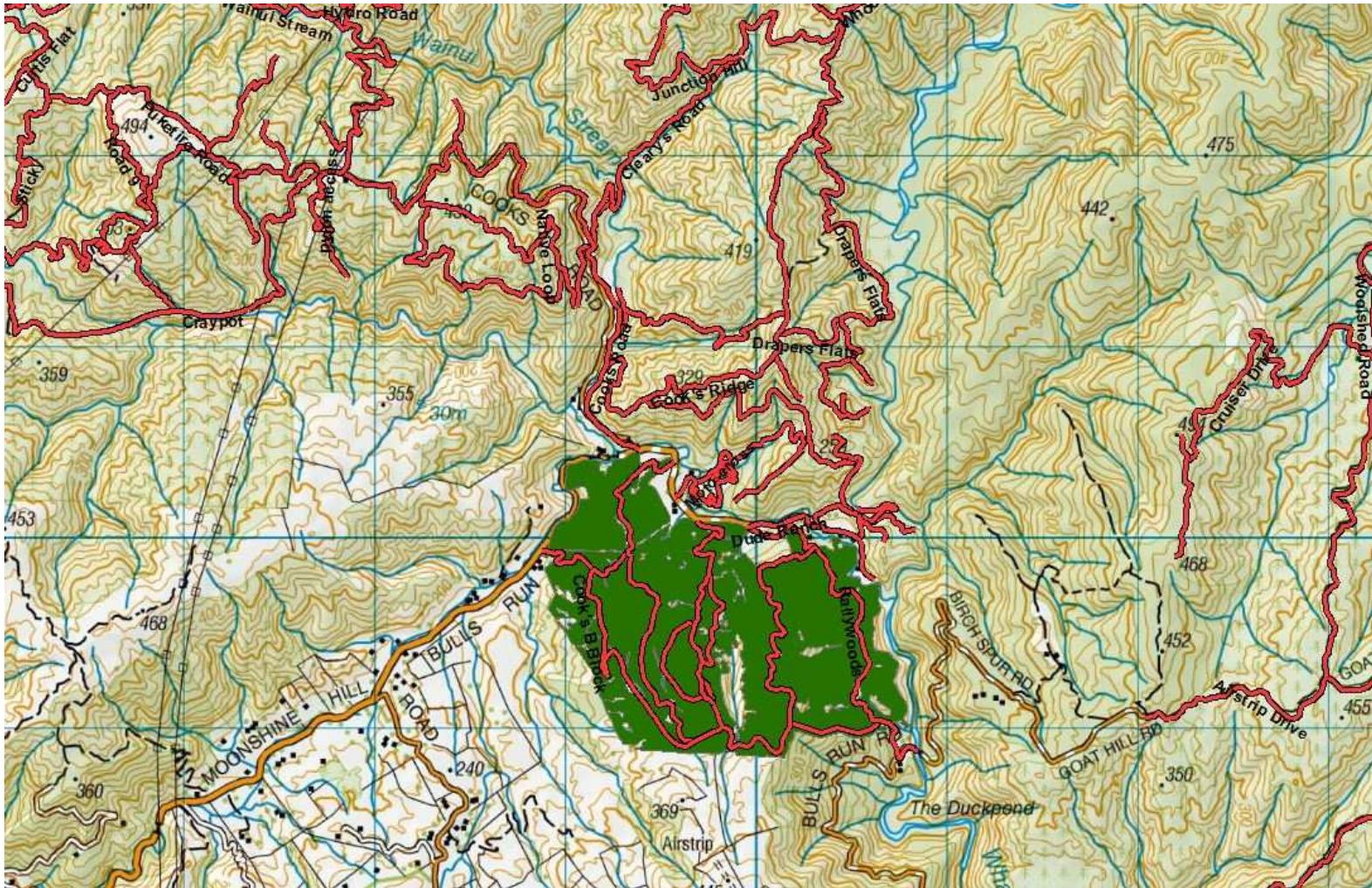
Pakuratahi Forest

**The speed limit in the Forest is 30kph
Please ensure that you obey this limit.
Not all vehicles are equipped with radios –
Drive to stop in half the clear distance ahead
All vehicles must have headlights on in forest**
