Note:

- **Slip on Clearys Road pass with care.**
- **Devils Staircase CLOSED to all motorised recreational users till November 15th.**
- **Hukinga Road Closed to all motorised recreation users due to road collapse.**
- **Scouring on Hydro Road above Wainui Stream proceed with care.**
- **Extra care needed when using all ford crossings.**
- **Whakatikei causeway culvert washout proceed pass with care.**
- **Whakatikei wetland closed to all motorised recreation users.**

Plantation Forestry

Valley View Forest

- Roadside mowing occurring on Valley View Road, Kilometre Rd and Boiler Gully.
- Harvesting Lindsays from marker 11 and spring road. Obey signage. Do not approach working machinery unless authorised by the harvesting crew. This operational area off limits to recreational use.
- Road maintenance machines and trucks working along Valley View and Lyndsays roads..
- Harvesting Woolshed road area. Obey signage. Do not approach working machinery unless authorised by the harvesting crew. This operational area off limits to recreational use.
- Thinning to waste in Rallywoods and Woolshed road areas. Obey signage.

Hukinga Forest

Puketiro Forest

- Contractor doing maintenance work on Puketiro Bridge Thursday 27th October.
- Road maintenance Puketiro road, Rallywoods Rd, Drapers road.
- Harvesting in Drapers road area. No access to this area while harvesting in progress. Some disruption to traffic flow on Puketiro road over coming months. Harvesting operations at the end of Number 9 road. Obey signage. Do not approach working machinery unless authorised by the harvesting crew. This operational area off limits to recreational use.
- Harvesting Main Loop Road area. No access to this area while harvesting in progress. Some disruption to access along Rallywoods road during this operation. Obey signage. Do not approach working machinery unless authorised by the harvesting crew. This operational area is off limits to recreational use.
- Grader operating along Rallywoods and Puketiro roads.
- **Logging traffic along Puketiro, Rallywoods, Airstrip, Valley View, Lindsays and Ragworts roads between 4am and 5pm weekdays. Radio communication on these roads at all times.**

Fire Danger

There are to be no fires lit within the exotic forest estate. Any fires need to be reported to the PF Olsen forest manager immediately.

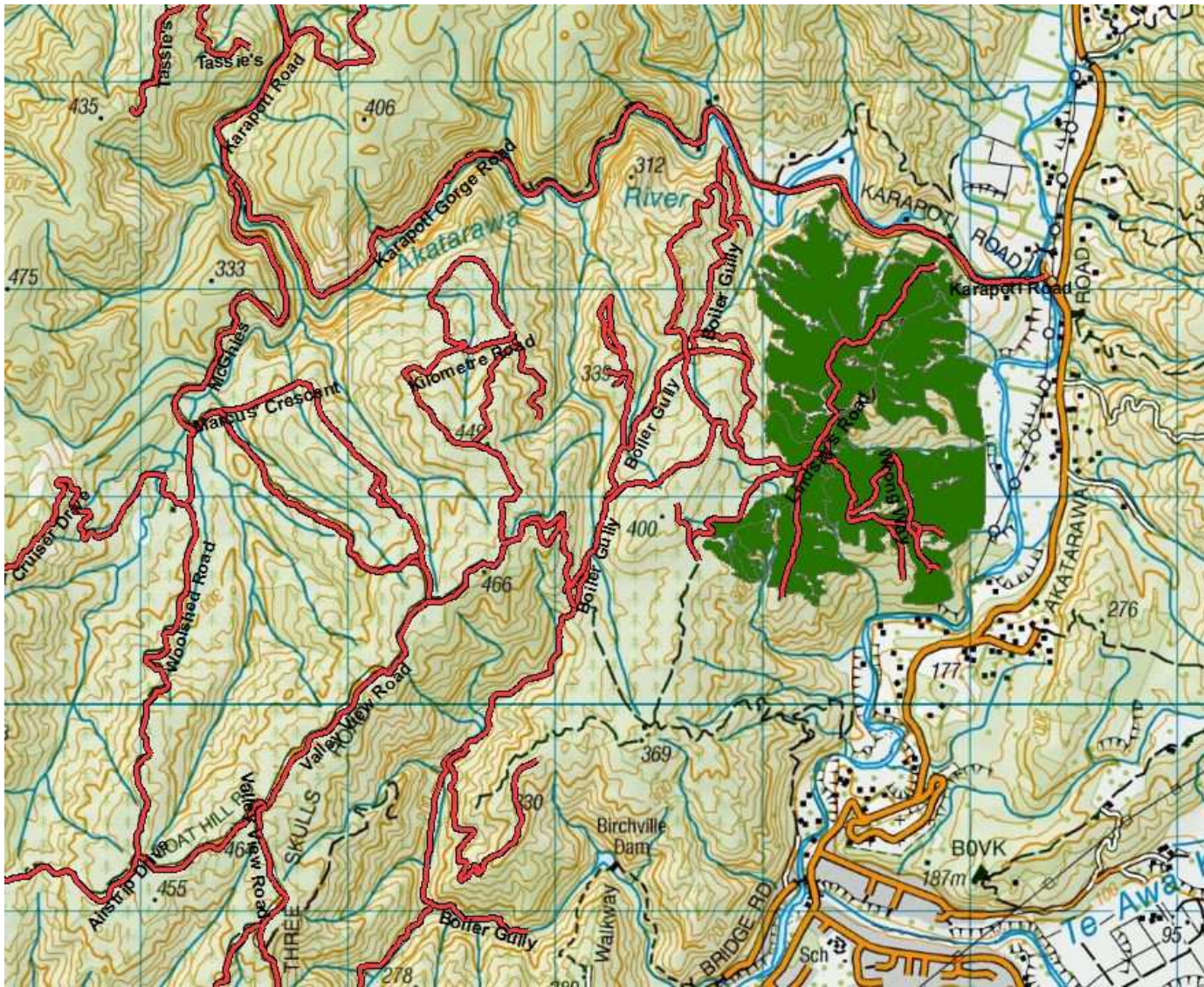
Pakuratahi Forest

All vehicles must have headlights on in forest**

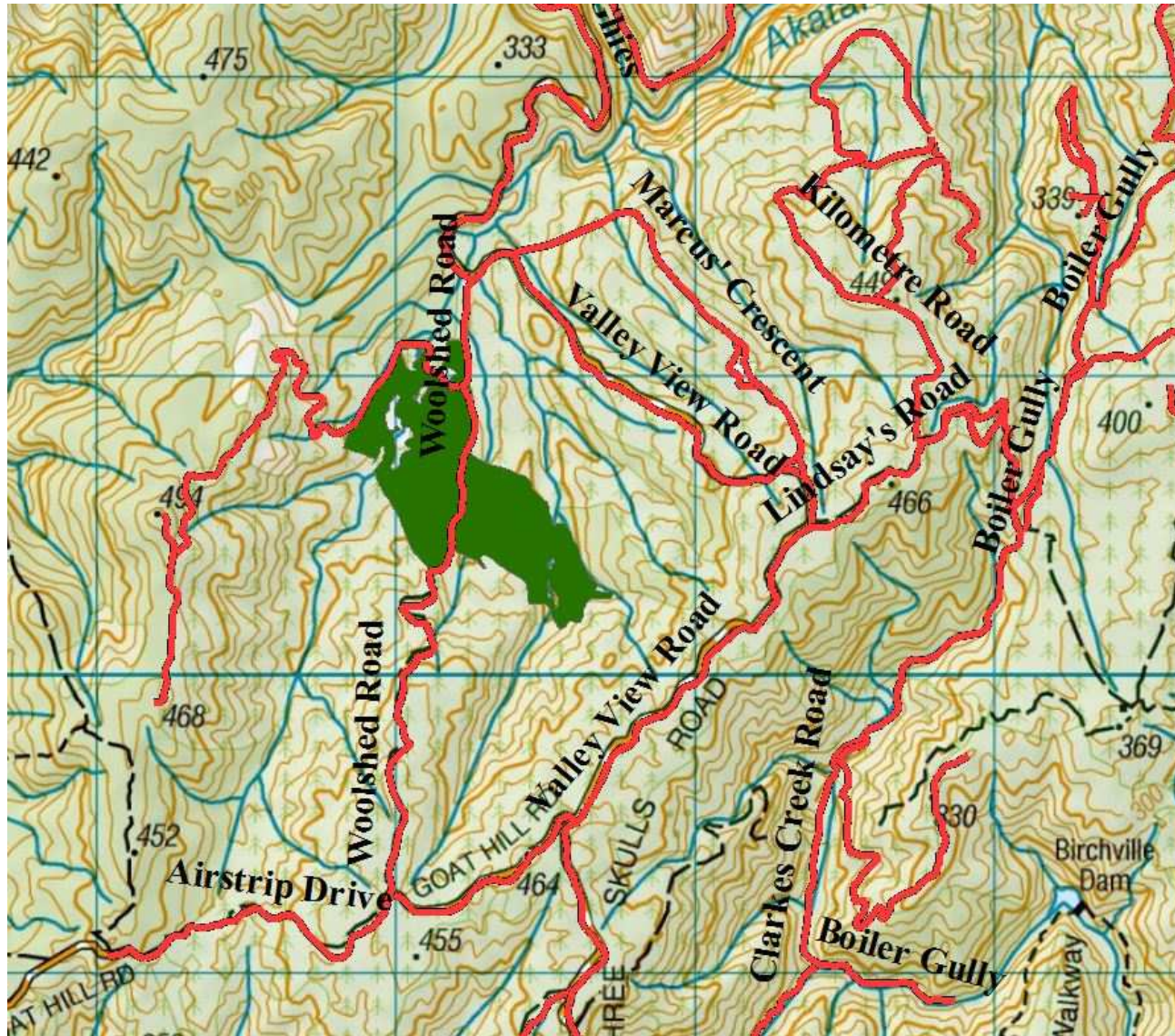
**BEWARE OF MOUNTAIN BIKES AND PEDESTRIANS ADJACENT TO

All vehicles MUST give way to loaded logging trucks

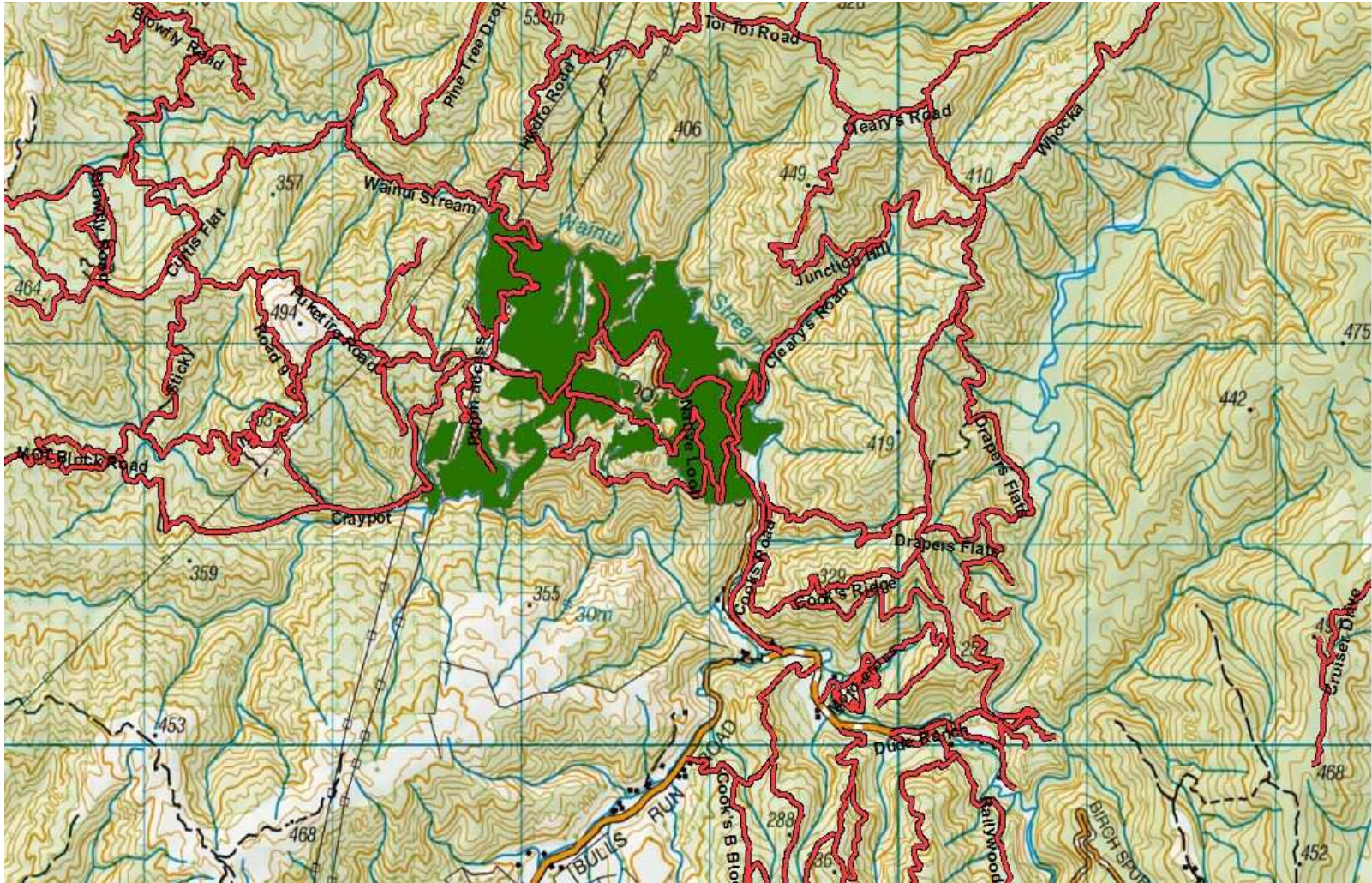


Valley View/Lindsays Rd Logging Sites

Valley View / Woolshed Road

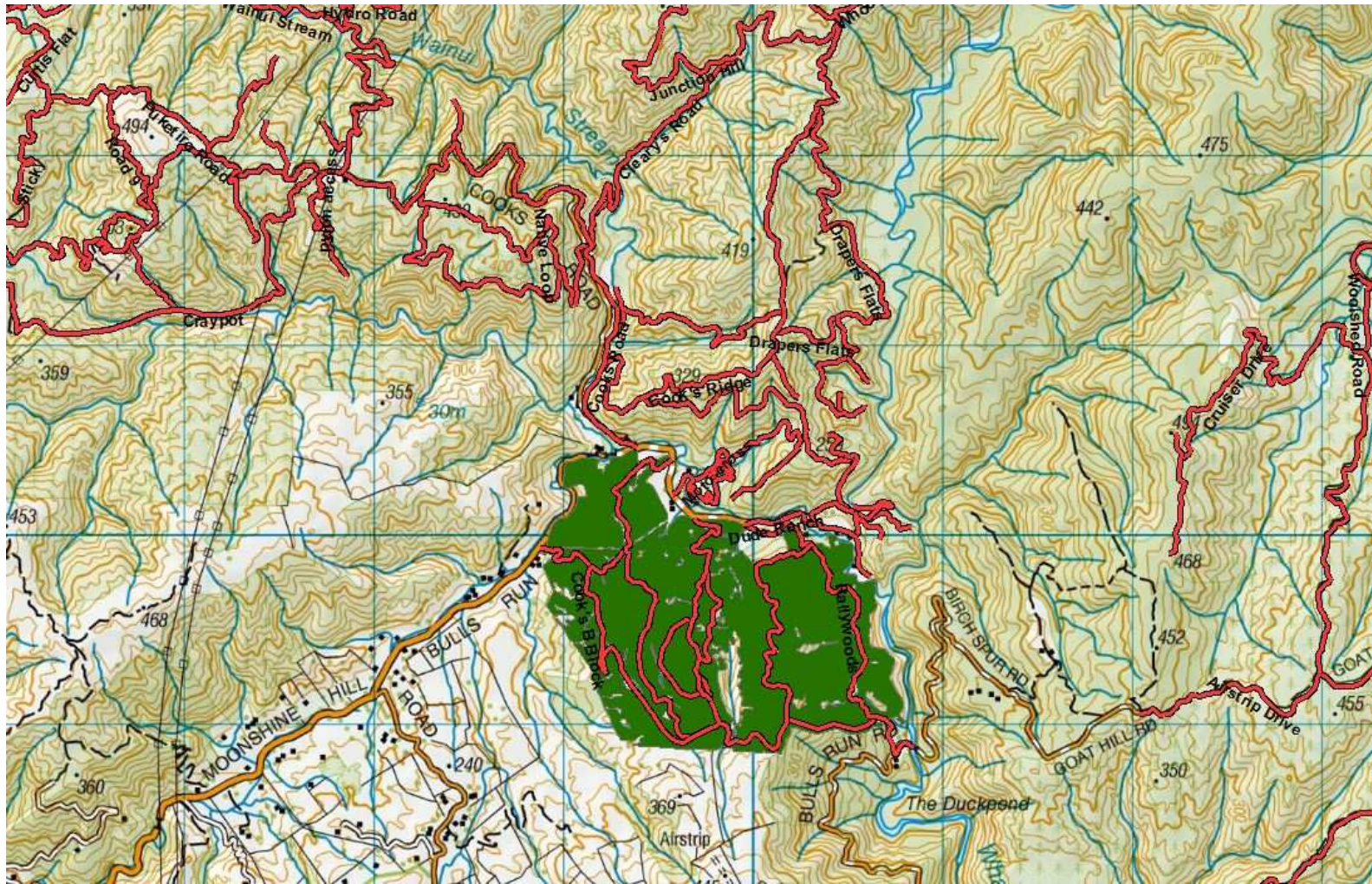


Drapers Logging Site
