Extra care needed when using all ford crossings.

Whakatikei causeway closed until further notice.

Wash outs on Whakatikei Road and Titi Road proceed pass with care.

Plantation Forestry

Valley View Forest

- Logging has started in Beech Spur. Beech Spur Road will be closed to public access for the duration of the logging operation.
- Logging and earthworks have ceased for the time being in Lindsay's Block.
- Logging in the Woolshed macrocarpa has been put on hold for the time being
- Aerial spraying in recently planted blocks (Lindsay's area) will occur over the coming weeks, subject to weather. Expect
 road closures when this happens
- Road maintenance as follows;
 - Tractor mounted sprayer controlling roadside weeds in the Rallywoods,
 - Beech Spur, Lindsays and Valley View roads
 - Grading of Valley View, Rallywoods and Lindsays Roads
 - Roadside mowing in the Three Skulls and Reservoir Ridge areas
 - Signage installation




Puketiro Forest

- Logging operations are underway in Drapers Block adjacent to Puketiro Rd. Puketiro Road will be closed for extended periods between the 14.5km and 16.5km marks whilst tree felling and harvesting occurs. This may last several months. Access to Cleary's Road may be possible following radio communication with the logging crew.
- Post-harvest operations are underway in Chesterfields and Cooks Ridge Road areas. No public access for the time being please. Fence repairs will be taking place near the Murphy property.
- Aerial spraying in recently planted blocks will occur over the coming weeks subject to weather. Expect road closures when this happens
- Earth moving machinery will be working on the north side of Hydro Road and exiting the forest through Puketiro Road over the next week.
- Thinning is ongoing in the block between Road 9 and 19km Puketiro Road. Please avoid access to the side roads in this area. Expect closures whilst roadside trees are felled.
- Thinning operations will soon start in the north side of the Blow Fly block
- Logging traffic along Puketiro, Rallywoods, Airstrip, Valley View, Lindsays and Ragworts roads between 4am and 5pm weekdays. Radio communication on these roads at all times.
- Following the recent wet weather, extra caution is required when driving on all the forests roads. Hazards including fallen trees, and debris, washouts and slips are likely. Drive to the conditions.

 The logging radio frequency will change on the 11th of May. The current frequency will not be usable in the forest from this date. Contact Richard Beamish-White (029 770 6223) or Chris Gibbons (027 478 8106) for more details.

Akatarawa Forest Block

- Greater Wellington Regional Council Rangers will be on Duty throughout the Forest
- Devil's Staircase route is CLOSED to ALL motorised vehicles until Labour weekend due to maintenance and settling process for track surface.
- Causeway Closed to vehicles due to wash out.
 - 19/10 30/11 Heavy machinery / excavator in use on Titi Road and Hydro Valley Road, Orange Hut Toitoi Rd.
 - 2/11 30/11 Programmed maintenance along Hukinga road and Pram Track. Involves use of heavy machinery / excavator. Note; Pram track will be closed to vehicles
- **Tobins Limited** Pylon maintenance (blasting and painting) will be carried out during the year (weather dependant) by Tobin's Ltd. Vehicles and crew will be entering and exiting Maungakotukutuku gate
- Electrix Limited is working in conjunction with United Group on the Pylons off Hydro Road
- Transpower Pylon maintenance on going may involve heavy machinery on Hydro Road.
- Police dog training school will be ongoing on the roads within the Valley View area, Valley View Forest
